Much like the battlefield, the fireground and emergency scene is a time-competitive environment. Subsequently, success and survival at fires and emergencies is largely determined by the ability to rapidly conduct tactical actions in a dynamic and uncertain environment. Peculiarly, many of the tactical and operational changes to impact the fire service in recent decades have not enhanced, but rather have impaired our operational cadence. This presentation establishes the importance of generating tactical and operational tempo as well as critical ingredients such as mutual trust.
